

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER RESTRICTING TRANSPORTATION OF YORK COUNTY PRISON INMATES TO JUDICIAL FACILITIES

AND NOW, this 2nd day of September, 2020, effective September 5, 2020 and continuing until further Order of this Court, York County Prison inmates shall not be transported to judicial facilities for any purpose except to participate in a criminal jury trial, and then only if the inmate is not subject to any quarantine conditions at the prison. The Court and all parties shall make maximum utilization of advanced communication technology to enable proceedings to continue throughout the duration of this restriction on transportation of inmates, as authorized by this Court's July 20, 2020 Order extending the judicial emergency arising from the COVID-19 pandemic. Any delay in case processing occasioned by this Order shall be attributable to the unavailability of the inmate.
